Monster Phonics aims is to create confident children and improve educational outcomes.

Monster Phonics is growing very quickly. Training is an important part of helping drive new schools to the programme. We are looking for phonics trainers with experience of **Reception and Key Stage 1 phonics**.

The Role

To deliver Monster Phonics training to teachers from multiple schools in a host school setting. The duration of each training session is 2 hours (including half an hour for questions and answers). You will be required to support the host school in preparing the room for training and ensuring that the technical aspects of the presentation are in place prior to the session. This will require you to arrive at the host school 45 minutes prior to the session. We would also like you to offer support to the host school in returning the room to its former state.

Monster Phonics is responsible for organising the training events. However, utilising your own network of schools will be beneficial as is sharing on social media platforms. We will work with you to ensure that the location, date and time are feasible for you. The number of training sessions that you regularly deliver will partly be determined by yourself and your commitments. After the initial time taken to organise events, this would ideally be up to one session per week.

All training material will be provided. You will also receive training so that you will be familiar with the concept, the programme and resources. As part of your training, you will be asked to observe one training session and be observed at the next. You will be paid the full amount for both of these sessions.

The role requires post-training follow-up via simple prescriptive emails to the attendees and headteachers of each school.

Remuneration

You will receive £200 per training session plus travel costs at 40p per mile.

Commission will be paid to you for each school that subscribes to Monster Phonics within 4 weeks of the training event. For every new customer that signs up via the training you will receive a £58 bonus.
